Here is your opportunity to honor, acknowledge and support those individuals that have served our community. Purchase a granite paver in the Walk of Honor at the new Veteran’s Memorial. Retired ACFD and APD members with a minimum of 10 years service are eligible for individualized pavers. People may honor the service of a Grandparent, Parent, Brother, Sister, Neighbor, or Friend that served our community.

**Eligibility for Individualized Paver:**

- Retired Anoka Champlin Fire Dept.
- Retired Anoka Police Dept.
- Minimum 10 years service

Veterans, Active Military, and Non-active Military of any branch including Reservists and National Guard that served during peace time are also eligible (separate order form required).

Citizens that wish to purchase a brick to show their support, without honoring an individual, may do so by purchasing a “Community Support” brick with standard inscription honoring our service members.
