



PARK & RECREATION BOARD

Powers & Duties

The Board shall advise and assist the City Council in matters relating to the natural resources and historic facilities of Anoka including all park and recreation programs of the City or Community Schools, all playgrounds, playfields, parks, golf courses, swimming pools, and other recreation facilities. The Board shall have no power to incur debt for which the City or any department thereof shall be liable and it shall have no power or authority to make any improvement, alterations, or changes in any of the parks or City facilities without the consent of the City Council. The Board will perform the following functions:

- To develop and maintain a comprehensive plan for the Anoka Park System which categorizes park and recreation areas and facilities.
- To make recommendations for the development and maintenance of these areas and facilities based on said plan
- To review proposed plot plans for new subdivisions and recommend to the City Council the park land dedication or cash in lieu of dedication which should be accepted and any proposed park and recreation areas or facilities which should be developed in the subdivision
- Propose to the City Council rules and regulations for the use of any parks or recreational facilities.
- Review all requests for the special use of such facilities and make recommendations to the City Council regarding such requests.
- Consider proper names for park and recreation areas and facilities and make recommendations to the City Council for such titles
- To conduct studies and investigations as specifically directed or delegated by the City Council.
- To represent the City Council at appropriate meetings, hearings, and the other events when so directed.
