



ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CITY STREET LIGHTS POLICY

I. General Policy Statement.

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines and consistency in the City's Street lighting practices. Street lighting is intended to provide a measure of public safety, by supporting vehicular and pedestrian safety on our City street system. However, this policy is not intended to be a substitute for good common sense on the part of pedestrians and drivers.

II. Policy Details.

As part of the City's street reconstruction and renewal program, the City shall strive to adhere to the following practices in the replacement of existing streetlights.

1. Existing mid-block streetlights will be replaced with decorative green fiberglass poles and a single acorn globe.
2. Low volume street intersections that have existing cobra head lights on wood poles will be replaced with decorative green fiberglass poles and a single acorn globe.
3. Existing wood poles will remain or be replaced when necessary or required by the City's Electric Utility.
4. Intersections or pedestrian crossings with higher volumes of traffic shall be lit with cobra head lights on decorative fiberglass poles where warranted, in the opinion of the City Engineer.
