



TEMPORARY ROADSIDE MEMORIALS POLICY

I. Purpose.

This policy provides a general guideline for the placement of temporary roadside memorial markers at the site of a fatal crash.

II. Policy.

Temporary memorials may be placed and remain on the roadside for an appropriate time, not to exceed six (6) months. Memorial markers will be removed if:

1. They do not meet safety criteria within the clear zone (physical or visual)
2. They negatively impact the free flow of traffic
3. They are located outside the clear zone but constitutes a hazard if hit by either on or off-roadway vehicles
4. They interfere with routine maintenance operations

Removed memorials will be stored for retrieval at Public Works for thirty (30) days prior to disposal.

As this is a policy, the City Council has a right to deviate from this policy if it is in the best interest of the City to do so.
